What information about you will we gather?

Essex and Suffolk Gliding Club Ltd collects certain information about members and visitors, which it uses to help it provide a service that is useful.

Members are asked to provide their name, contact details, flying experience and qualification as well as other personal information.

Where will personal information about you be stored?

Essex and Suffolk Gliding Club Ltd. will store the information that you provide to us on computer equipment and paper records. By supplying such information, you consent to the above storage.

How will personal information about you be used by us?

Personal information about members may be used for one or more of the following purposes:

- To contact members
- To provide information required by law and to contact relatives following an incident or accident.
- To advise members on their balance of account for flying fees

Save as aforesaid, we will not make disclosure of your personal information to any person, firm or company without first obtaining your prior written consent to do so.

If you do not wish us to use your personal information for one or more of the above purposes, please let us know by contacting us by letter, fax, telephone or e-mail.

How can you correct or revise the personal information about you

If you want us to correct or change any personal or other information about you held by us, please let us know by e-mail, telephone, fax or letter to the club number or address.

While we take reasonable steps to safeguard your personal information from unauthorized access, you should recognize that e-mail and other electronic transmissions are insecure. Accordingly Essex and Suffolk Gliding Club Ltd do not warrant, guarantee or undertake that any transmission will not be intercepted and/or read by an unauthorized person.

Law and jurisdiction

You and Essex and Suffolk Gliding Club Ltd agree that these terms and conditions shall be governed in all respects by English law and that the English courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of any dispute, claims or other matters arising out of your use of this site or the information appearing on it.

Web Site Privacy Policy

What the Privacy Policy means and what is covered

We are committed to maintaining the privacy of personal information that you provide to us when visiting or using our web site, and we will comply with all Data Protection Act requirements. Information We Collect

General

If you register with us, we will collect personally identifiable information from you that may include your name, age, address, e-mail address and facts about your computer, profession, flying experience and similar information. This data is kept secure and will only be used for the purpose that you are providing it for and will not be passed on to a third party.

Accessing Personal Information

You may review and update your personal identifiable registration information at anytime. If you wish to no longer receive information you can opt out by contacting the Webmaster. Any queries on your registered information should be directed to the Webmaster.

Additional Subscription Facilities

Should additional subscription facilities be added to **esgc.co.uk** you will be given the opportunity to opt-in to them. You will only receive information on items that you have agreed to.

Surveys

We may conduct occasional online surveys. These surveys are entirely voluntary and you do not have to participate.

Web Site Usage Information

IP addresses and website usage information is automatically collected from you when you visit **esgc.co.uk**. This information helps us evaluate how visitors and subscribers use and navigate **esgc.co.uk** on an aggregate basis, including the number and frequency of visitors and subscribers to each web page, and the length of their visits.

How We Use Information Collected

Summary of terms

Browser

Used to locate and display Web pages via a software application. The most popular ones are Netscape Navigator and Microsoft Internet Explorer.

Cookie

When you sign on to esgc.co.uk or take advantage of several key features, we may pass cookies to your computer. A cookie is a string of information that is sent by the website and stored on your hard drive or temporarily in your computer's memory. These can be easily removed.

IP (Internet Protocol)
